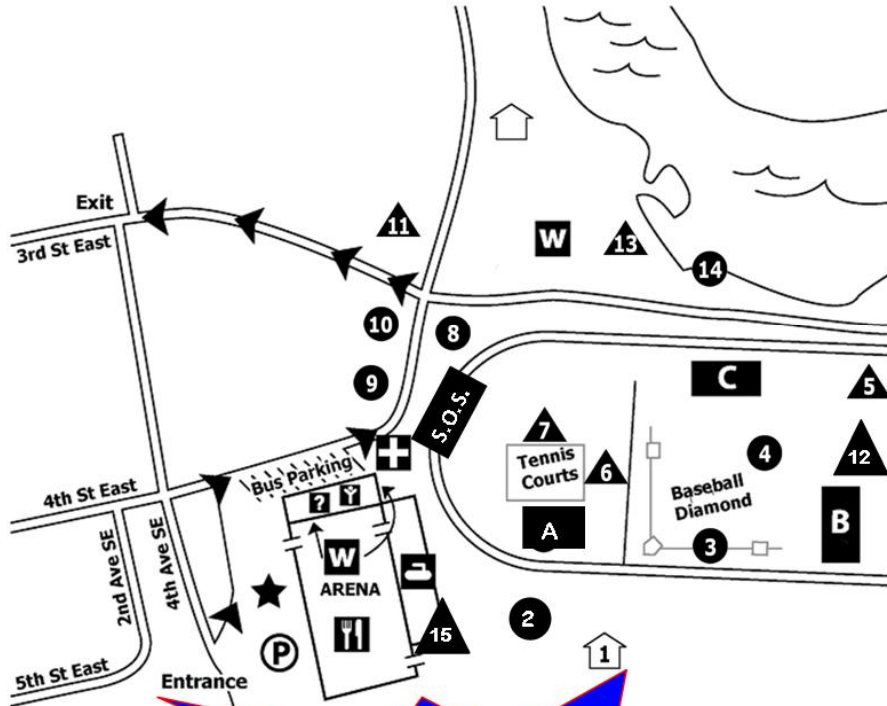

## On the Day of Your Visit

- 💧 The Festival will be held rain or shine! Please dress appropriately as most activities are outdoors.
- 💧 Upon arrival at the Chesley Community Centre, please have all students wait on the bus until a Festival host greets you, who will give you special instructions for the day. For the safety and security of all, please give the Festival volunteer an accurate number of students and adults attending the Festival from your school.
- 💧 Lunch is scheduled from 11:30 - 12:15 p.m. All activities will close during this time. All students and chaperones must remain in the arena during the designated lunchtime.
- 💧 Blue or Orange t-shirts, with the Grey Bruce Children's Water Festival logo on the front, will help to identify Festival volunteers. Volunteers will be located in many areas throughout the site. Should any questions arise, feel free to ask any volunteer. They will be happy to assist you.
- 💧 The Festival ends at 2:00 p.m. All activities will shut down at that time.
- 💧 Please help us improve our service to you by completing the evaluation form you will receive upon arrival. At lunchtime, you may drop your completed evaluation form in one of the drop boxes located at each arena exit. *Thank you!*

## Basic Rules & Safety Protocol

*To ensure a fun and safe day please review the points below*

- ♦ St. John Ambulance will be on site, located on the arena side of the track.
- ♦ The Festival will run rain or shine. Please come prepared for the possibility of wet and cold weather.
- ♦ Please ensure children stay in their groups and are accompanied by an adult at all times. (including washroom breaks)
- ♦ Group leaders are to be fully aware of any medical conditions and/or allergies within their group.
- ♦ Due to allergies the Festival requires lunches and snacks to be peanut/nut free.
- ♦ Festival Organizers, identified by the blue coloured t-shirts, will be located throughout the site. If you have any safety concerns, please speak to a Festival Organizer.
- ♦ In the event of a child going astray, please advise a Festival Organizer or St. John Ambulance and they will be able to assist you.
- ♦ In the event of an emergency, such as sudden severe weather, you will hear three long siren blows indicating immediate evacuation to the arena to await further instructions.
- ♦ We request that participants DO NOT bring two-way radios as it interferes with our emergency communication lines.
